Map Subject Area Coverage

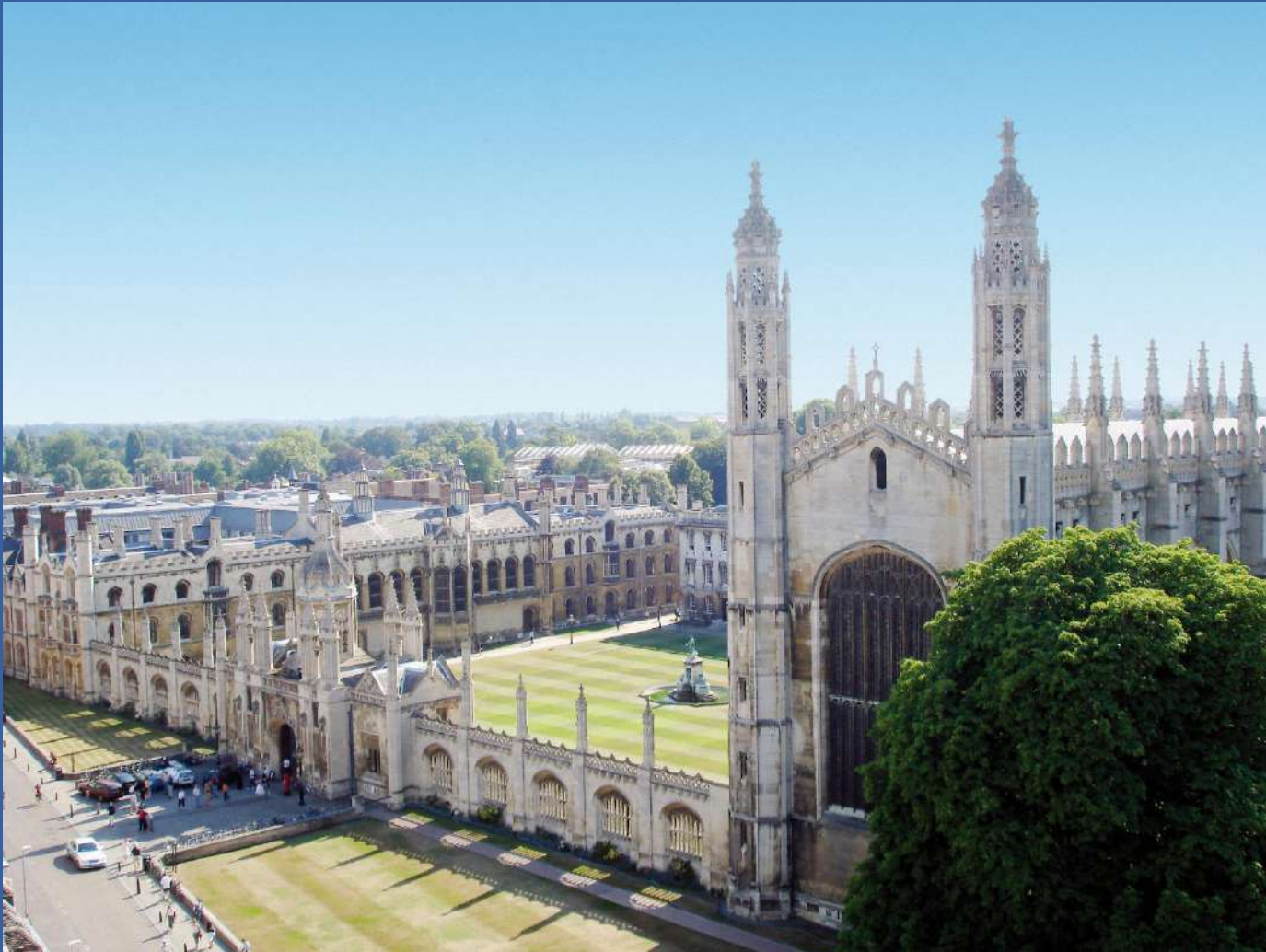
