Education

Pharm D (Clinical Pharmacy) Credit Hours System

Degree requirements: 175 credit hours distributed over 10 semesters The cumulative GPA should not be less than 2 + Passing the university's requirements for graduation + Passing a field training period with a total of 100 actual training hours total grades of a subject: total grades of (mid-terms + practical* written + oral) and the minimum requirements to pass in any course is 60% of its total degrees.



Duration of study - five academic years (five levels over ten semesters) according to the credit hours system + one year training (excellence) in the workplace + 100 hours field training.

The year of training (excellence) = training courses in the various areas of clinical pharmacy + one training course in the field of pharmaceutical manufacturing and other + The student also presents a graduation project in a particular specialty.

Each level (academic year) is divided into two semesters (fall and spring) and each semester is 15 weeks. Some courses may be offered in a 6-8-weeks of intensive study during summer semester.

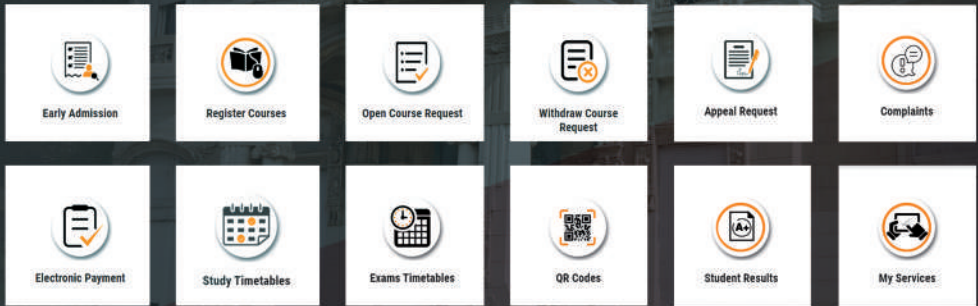
