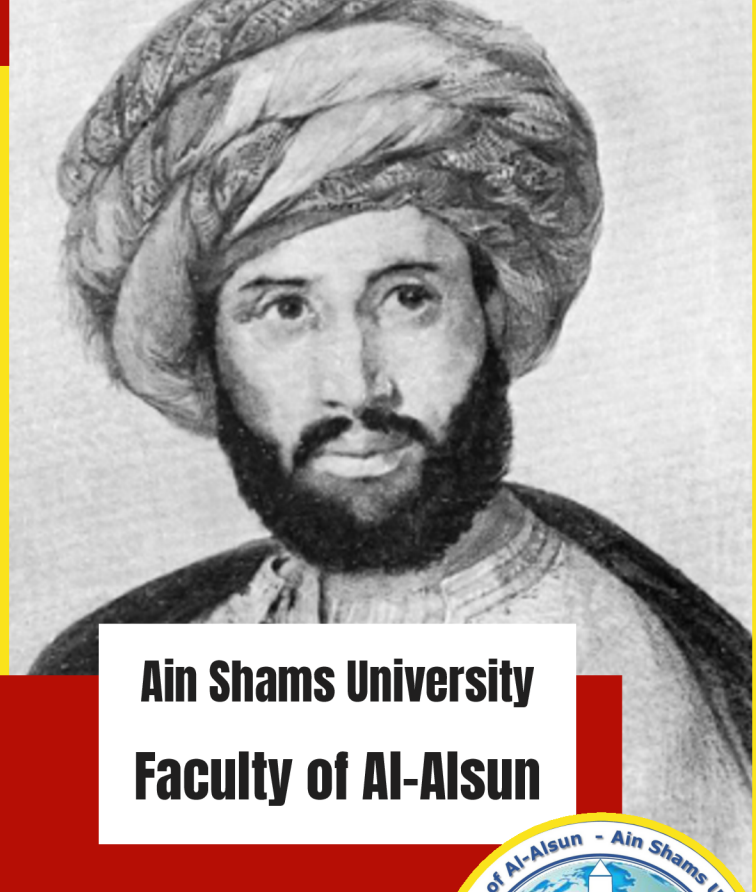

Specialized Translation Program in Chinese

Why the Specialized Translation Program in Chinese?

1

The Department of Chinese at the Faculty of Al-Alsun, Ain Shams University, is the most prestigious Chinese language department among Egyptian, Arab, and African universities.

The department brings in native Chinese professors to teach in the program.

It offers opportunities for a number of students to participate in summer and winter camps in collaboration with the Confucius Institute at the university.

It supports student participation in Chinese language competitions and cultural events held both in Egypt and abroad.

It provides outstanding job opportunities in collaboration with leading Chinese companies, such as Huawei, Haier, and others.



Language of Instruction

Specialized courses are taught in **Chinese** as the primary language, in addition to courses taught in **Arabic**, as well as in **English** as a second foreign language.

Number of Study Years / Credit Hours Required for Graduation

A four-year program comprising 144 credit hours, divided into four levels over eight semesters (with a minimum duration of 14 weeks per semester).

Field Training During Study

- Field training is a graduation requirement, whereby the student must finish 60 hours of training.
- The program qualifies its students for training at various organizations, such as:
 - Tourism companies
 - Airlines
 - Media institutions
 - Information technology companies
 - Schools

Agreements and International Cooperation

- **Agreements with several Chinese universities**, including Beijing Foreign Studies University and Northwest University of China.
- **Agreements with the Chinese National Center for Language Exchange.**
