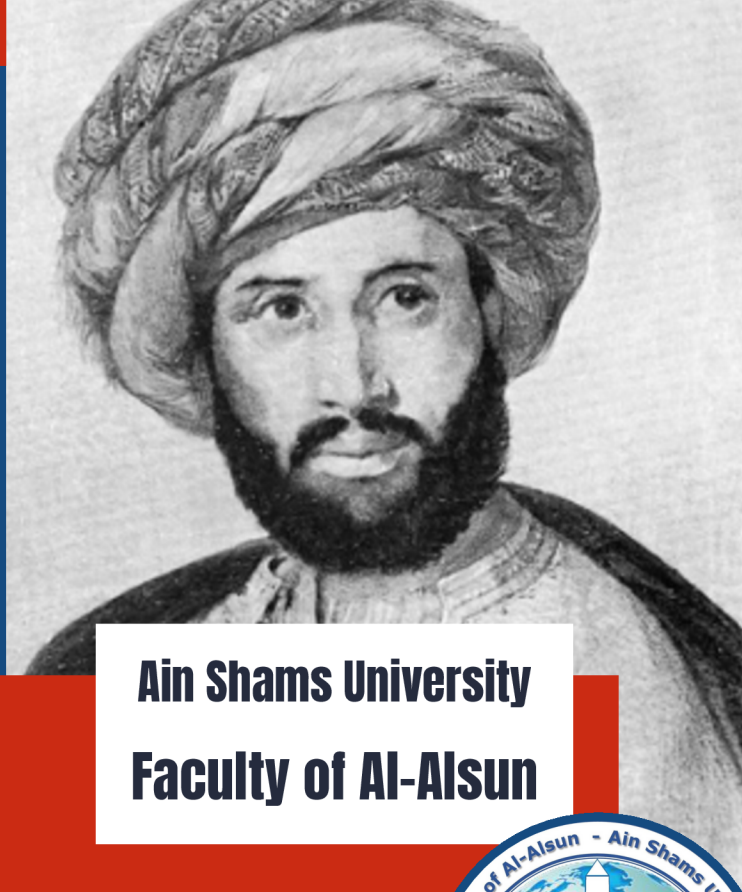




Program Admission Requirements

Why the Written Translation and Simultaneous Interpreting Program in French?

The program includes a number of distinguished professors who work in the field of written and simultaneous translation.

The classrooms are appropriately sized for the number of students.

Listening, conversation, and simultaneous interpretation courses are taught in specialized labs.

Courses related to the job market are offered, such as screen translation, simultaneous interpretation, translation and tourist guidance, in addition to French for secretarial purposes

References related to the courses are available in the library.

The program supports students' annual participation in the judging committee for the Goncourt Prize for the Middle East (Goncourt le choix de l'Orient).



Language of Instruction

Specialized courses are taught in **French** as the primary language, in addition to courses taught in **Arabic**, as well as in **English** as a second foreign language.

Number of Study Years / Credit Hours Required for Graduation

4 academic years / 144 credit hours distributed across 4 levels over 8 semesters (each semester lasts a minimum of 14 weeks)

Students are divided into the Written Translation track or the Written and Simultaneous Translation track after successfully completing the second-year courses.

Field Training During Study

- Field training is a graduation requirement, whereby the student must finish 60 hours of training throughout the 4 years of study. It is evaluated as Pass/Fail only, and is not included in the GPA.
- The program qualifies its students for training at various organizations, such as:
 - Cairo International Forum for University Theater
 - Middle East News Agency
 - Al-Ahram Hebdo Newspaper
 - Le Progrès Egyptien Newspaper
 - Ministry of Youth and Sports
 - Some tourism companies

Agreements and International Cooperation

- **Cooperation Agreement between Ain Shams University and the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF)**, including training courses tailored for students of the program and opportunities to participate in the international literary competition "Goncourt – Le Choix de l'Orient."
