Education

Bachelor of Pharmacy- Pharm D (Clinical Pharmacy)- Credit Hours System Degree requirements:

175 credit hours distributed over 10 semesters. The cumulative GPA should not be less than 2.00 + Passing the university's requirements for graduation. Study Language: English. Course evaluation: Includes periodicals, practical, written, and oral exams. The minimum requirement to pass any course is 60% of its total marks.

Duration of Study (5+1): Five academic years (five levels distributed over ten semesters) + one academic year of advanced field training. Each level (academic year) is divided into two semesters (Fall & Spring). Each semester includes 15 weeks. Some courses may be offered in a 6–8 week intensive study during the summer semester

Field of Training

- A Introductory field training (100 actual training hours): During summer, the student must complete a supervised training with a total number of 100 actual training hours, in private, government pharmacies and hospital pharmacies sites during summer vacations after the end of the third or fourth level of study.
- B- Advanced Field Training (year of excellence): During the sixth year, PharmD clinical Students have to surpass 3 clinical rotations; 1 mandatory rotation in adult general medicine including cardiology, hepatology, nephrology and gastroenterology in addition to 2 elective clinical rotations including: critical care, pediatrics, geriatrics, oncology, surgery, and gynecology. all these rotations will be in the vast Ain shams university hospitals, also the students have to surpass 1 pharmacy-based rotation within Ain shams university outpatient and inpatient pharmacies, it will allow them to understand the pharmacist's integral role in the healthcare team.

The program is distinguished by graduation projects in a specific specialty that contributes to preparing the student for the real world. The students are supervised by professors entering the laboratories, performing different investigations, in the majority of projects, research papers are published in highly indexed journals. It is worth noting that the projects are funded and are finally reviewed by a committee of the esteemed college professors, Awards are given to the winner projects.
