

Admission Procedures

- ✓ The student must submit copies of the birth certificate, the Coordination Office Placement Card, and the Secondary Education Certificate.
- ✓ The student nominated by the Coordination Office must submit the required documents to the Student Affairs Department at the Faculty, then obtain a file from the Credit Hour Programs Administration and pay the prescribed examination fees.
- ✓ Students who have achieved the minimum admission score required for Al-Alsun Faculties but were not placed at the Faculty of Al-Alsun – Ain Shams University through the Coordination Office must submit copies of their birth certificate, placement card, and the Secondary Education Certificate in order to obtain the Dean's approval to initiate a manual transfer file at Ain Shams University Coordination Office and pay the transfer fees.
- ✓ Acceptance of the transfer is conditional upon passing the required admission exams and paying the prescribed admission fees.
