Education

Bachelor of Pharmacy-PharmD (Clinical Pharmacy)- Credit Hours System Degree requirements:

175 credit hours distributed over 10 semesters. The cumulative GPA should not be less than 2 + Passing the university's requirements for graduation + Passing a summer field training period with a total of 100 actual training hours. Study language: English. Course evaluation: includes periodicals, practical, written and oral exams and the minimum requirements to pass any course is 60% of its total marks.



Duration of study (5+1): Five academic years (five levels distributed over ten semesters) + one academic year of advanced field training (excellence).

The advanced field training (year of excellence) includes six rotations in different work places each of six weeks, and presentation of a graduation research project.


Each level (academic year) is divided into two semesters (Fall & Spring)
Each semester includes 15 weeks. Some courses may be offered in a 6-8 weeks of intensive study during summer semester.
