


Program Admission Requirements

Why the Specialized Translation Program in Spanish?

The Department of Spanish at the Faculty of Al-Alsun, Ain Shams University, is the oldest educational and academic institution offering Spanish language instruction in Egypt and the Arab world.

The program offers courses aligned with labor market demands, such as screen translation, consecutive and simultaneous interpretation, tourism translation, and computer-assisted translation.

- It provides a rich and modern academic environment under the supervision of specialized faculty members.
- Courses in conversation, reading, and writing are taught by native-speaking instructors.
- It enhances the quality of education through collaboration with prestigious international institutions.
- It supports student participation in scientific, cultural, and professional events.



Language of Instruction

Specialized courses are taught in **Spanish** as the primary language, in addition to courses taught in **Arabic**, as well as in **English** as a second foreign language.

Number of Study Years / Credit Hours Required for Graduation

A four-year program comprising 144 credit hours, divided into four levels over eight semesters (with a minimum duration of 14 weeks per semester).

Field Training During Study

- Field training is a graduation requirement, whereby the student must finish 60 hours of training.
- The program qualifies its students for training at various organizations, such as:
 - Embassies of Spanish-speaking countries
 - Association for Spanish Culture Enthusiasts
 - State Information Service
 - Selected tourism companies
 - Ministry of Youth and Sports

Agreements and International Cooperation

- Student exchange agreements with prestigious Spanish universities, offering outstanding students opportunities to study abroad.
- A memorandum of understanding between Ain Shams University and the Spanish Agency for International Development Cooperation, to support the program with native-speaking instructors.
- A joint Egyptian-European Master's program, in collaboration with the University of Salamanca, Spain.
