Education

Graduated with honour as a Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery in 1988 from Ain Shams Medical School, I fulfilled my residency in The Neuropsychiatry Department, granted a Master's degree in Neuropsychiatry in 1992. Thereafter appointed as faculty at the same Department. I achieved my *Professorship in 2007* and was appointed to this position till present. I hold a Diploma of Mental Health Practices, a joint certificate Ain Shams Medical School and UMDS London (1996). I also accomplished the Global Tobacco control certificate Program in 2012 from Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health.

Work history: Since 2015, I head the Women's mental health and Tobacco control and cessation programs. Appointed as *Head of Consultation Liaison Psychiatry Unit in 2020*. Earlier, I worked with the *World Health Organisation-Eastern Mediterranean* and WR offices as Technical Officer in the Division Health Protection and Promotion (2006-2007). In recognition of my outstanding performance in WHO, I was appointed *Director of the Regional office on Tobacco control, Branch of International Union Against TB and Lung Disease-Paris* (The Union) in the Middle East to supervise the Bloomberg Global Initiative Grants program in the region (2007-2015).

International Consultantship: I was also appointed part time International Faculty on Project Management at the International Management and Development Program IMDP.

National Consultantship: Earlier in my career I spearheaded two major national programs one under the patronage of the Ministry of Health, as Consultant to the Health Minister and Director of Hotline Service for Addiction Prevention and Treatment (2000-2002); the other was a project directed by the UN office on Drugs and Crime where I was appointed Executive Manager of the National Program for the Primary Prevention of Drug abuse in Egypt (1999-2000).

Biography:

I received my Professorship in 2007, currently I am Senior Prof of Psychiatry and Head of the Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry Unit (till Jan 2025), and Women Mental Health Program-WMH (since 2015) and Senior WMH Advisor to the Safe Women Advocacy National Service.

In 2014, I spearheaded the official inauguration of the WMH program aiming to institutionalize and enhance the clinical service, research, educational and health care to women particularly mothers. Since then, WMH has become well-integrated in all postgraduate education curricula and a fundamental component of competence appraisal, skill assessment and accreditation of certified psychiatrists. In my role as Advisor of the National Medical Internship Program in Psychiatry, I directed that maternal mental health care practice be incorporated within core competencies of mental health practice of interns to be qualified. The program was officially endorsed and implemented by the Ministry of Higher Education, 2024.

I achieved success in bringing WMH to the attention of key clinical disciplines. Currently, Perinatal Mental Health is a key session in multidisciplinary conferences of the Ob-Gyn. I am an invited key speaker to Ob-Gyn Dept Annual Int'l Conference and the Foundation of Ob, Reproductive Health and Gyn Surg. Egypt.

As Advisor to Safe Women Advocacy National Service, we provide mental health multidisciplinary service to survivors of all forms of gendered violence across the nation.

Considering public mental health a priority area of service, I lead the promotion and dissemination of the **5As approach to tobacco control and cessation** in diverse clinical settings. In this respect, as Head of both the WMH and Tobacco control programs, I inaugurated the **Perinatal Smoking cessation clinic to be first of its kind consultation-liaison service** helping mothers-to-be and women of reproductive potential to control their smoking habit.

I initiated the first regional group for the MENA at the Marcé Society for Perinatal MH in 2021 to help bring to light this underrepresented region. Still emerging, but with Marcé leads and members we are promoting and expanding it.

From 2007-2015, I was The Regional Director of the Middle East Office Branch of The International Union Against Tuberculosis and Lung Diseases to supervise the grants projects supported by the Bloomberg Global Initiative on Tobacco Control in the region. I then moved on to serve as International Faculty in Project Management for Public Health Programs, I worked with several governmental institutes, civil societies, country offices and international bodies like WHO, Ministries of Health Kenya, Brazil, Rwanda, Kyrgyzstan, Guam to provide consultation and technical assistance on their national health programs provided through renowned International initiatives such as **Vital Strategies, CDC Improving Public Health Management for Action** (**IMPACT**) and Resolve to Save Lives-**Program Management for Epidemic Preparedness** (**PMEP**). My research interests span a range of topics, including the impact of technology and online gaming on mental health, the prevalence of psychiatric morbidity in perinatal women, and the societal attitudes towards smoke-free policies in Egypt just as examples of several other research domains.

My work is characterized by a deep understanding of the cultural nuances that influence mental health in Egypt and the region, demonstrating a comprehensive approach to understanding and addressing priority mental health issues.

My international publications vividly reflect my 25 years profound experience with WMH issues spanning across national, to regional and international levels. Looking into my co-authored publication on Women's mental health and lessons learnt from the COVID-19 pandemic reflects my spanning experience. My interest in spotlighting risky issues in WMH is reflected in my co-authored article on Perinatal Psychoactive Substances Use: A Rising Perinatal Mental Health Concern.
