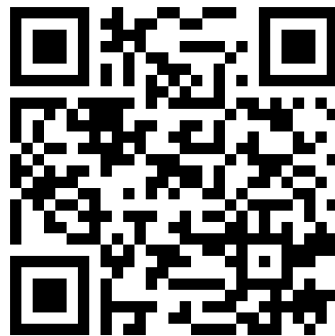

• **Personal Statement:**

Mohamed Gamal Qassem, MBBCh, MSc, MD, IMRCS (Eng) is a Clinical Associate Professor of Bariatric and GIT Surgery at Ain Shams University, Cairo, Egypt. His main duties include performing surgical operations on both elective and emergency bases at a consultant level, training of junior surgeons, conducting research work and participation in the formal teaching for senior medical students. He has been a member of the Royal College of Surgeons in England since October, 2014.

He graduated from Ain Shams Faculty of Medicine in June 2009 with grade excellent with honor. He obtained MSc degree and MD degree in General Surgery from the same university in 2013 and 2016 respectively. His MD thesis is entitled as "Factors Contributing to Local Recurrence After Conservative Breast Surgery For Early Breast Cancer".

Throughout his post-graduate studies, Dr Qassem received accredited basic surgical training during structured three-year residency program covering most General Surgery subspecialties; Colorectal, UGI, Laparoscopic, Bariatric, HBP, Breast and Endocrine Surgery. Over the following three years, he completed his advanced surgical training in Laparoscopic, Colorectal and Bariatric Surgery, and eventually was granted the degree of consultant in Egypt.

He has been appointed as Specialty Doctor of Bariatric and UGI Surgery in Royal Shrewsbury Hospital, UK, where he received training in Bariatric procedures like LSG, LRYGB and Gastric Balloons, and benign UGI operations like Laparoscopic anti-reflux procedures and Laparoscopic CBD exploration. Also, he worked as Senior Clinical Fellow of GIT Surgery in Brighton and Sussex University Hospital, UK, where he received training in Laparoscopic Colorectal and UGI cancer resections and benign surgeries as well.
